eyeGO FAQ for Students

How can I find out about eyeGO eligible shows at The Port Theatre?

Almost all of The Port Theatre Spotlight shows, and a selection of community events, have eyeGO pricing. The easiest way to find them is to go to our website, go to the "Events & Tickets" drop-down menu and click "eyeGO Events". If you have heard about a show that you would like to see, you can check the event details to see if it has the eyeGO logo at the bottom of the page.

How can I buy tickets?

You can buy eyeGO tickets in person at the Ticket Centre, or over the phone. If you order your ticket over the phone, we will hold it for you to pick up in person at the Ticket Centre. You must bring your student ID to get it!

What if I don't have a student card?

No problem! Just ask a teacher at your school to send us a letter on school letterhead stating that you are enrolled for the current school year. Then when you come to the Ticket Centre to pick up your tickets, just show us a secondary form of ID to confirm.

Can I buy an eyeGO ticket for a friend?

You can buy up to 2 eyeGO tickets at a time, one for you and one for a friend who must also be in high school. One of you must show your student card at the Ticket Centre.

Can my parents buy tickets for me?

This isn't about them, it's about you! You have to contact the Ticket Centre in person or over the phone to order your own ticket, and must be the one to present your student ID. **Parents cannot do this on a student's behalf.**

If I'm not in high school yet, can I purchase an eyeGO ticket?

No. This program is designed to encourage independence in secondary school students to check out the amazing live performance our community has to offer. This applies to students from grade 8-12 only.
